



Law - Special prizes

- **Criteria and weighting**

1. Priority will be given to theses that have been awarded the International Distinction.
2. For theses that have not been awarded the International Distinction the evaluation criteria and their corresponding points are as follows:
 - Publications (books with respected and renowned publishers, book chapters, articles in indexed journals): 50 points
 - Papers presented at international and national conferences and seminars: 10 points
 - Study visits abroad: 10 points
 - Participation in R+D projects: 10 points
 - Prizes and grants: 10 points

- **Required complementary documentation**

Candidates for the Special Doctoral Prize must provide the necessary documentation to accredit all the merits cited in their curriculum vitae. If they do not present this documentation, the merits will not be taken into consideration.
