- **Criteria and weighting**
 1. Number of publications deriving from the thesis (consideration will be given to the candidate's position in the order of authorship, the quartile of the journals in which the articles have been published and their impact index) **(70%)**
 2. European/international distinction **(20%)**
 3. Other merits (participation in conferences, projects, grants, training courses, etc.) **(10%)**
- **Required complementary documentation**

- publications (put all the information on publications on the [accompanying template](#)) (it is not necessary to present paper copies of publications if they are available online)
- participation in conferences
- participation in projects
- grants
- study visits abroad
- training courses
