- Publications international peer reviewed journals: 45%
 Both the number of publications and order of authorship will be evaluated
- Non-peer review publications: 20%
 Both the number of publications and order of authorship will be evaluated
- Papers presented at conferences: 10%
 Both the number of publications and order of authorship will be evaluated
- Study visits abroad: 15%
 Study visits of over a year will be evaluated as excellent
- Participation in projects and in leadership of archaeological excavations 10%
 Leadership of archaeological excavations and participation in research projects will be evaluated as excellent
- Required complementary documentation
