Special prizes

- **Criteria and weighting**

Students will be eligible for a special prize if they obtain a minimum of 15 points in accordance with the criteria in the table below.

The candidates will be put in order depending on their total scores. If there is a tie, the committee will give the reasons for its final decision in a report.

The total score is obtained by adding together the following:

1	Article in an ISI-JCR journal 1st decile	10
2	Article in ISI-JCR journal Q1	8
3	Article in ISI-JCR journal Q2	7
4	Article in ISI-JCR journal Q3 or Q4	5
5	Patents approved	5*
6	Patents that have been sent for a PCT application	7*
7	Patents with exploitation agreement	8*
8	Papers presented at international conferences (peer review)	3
9	Papers presented at international conferences	2
10	Papers presented at national conferences	1
11	Research visits (3 months)	3
	Prizes, individual grants and other merits	Merit to be evaluated by the academic committee
