



Neuroscience - Special prizes

- **Criteria and weightings**
- European/international thesis **2/10**
- Quantity and quality of publications deriving from thesis in indexed journals. The academic committee will evaluate the impact of the journal, the quartile and decile that it is in, citations, etc. **3/10**
- Books and book chapters published by renowned publishers as decided by the Academic Committee. **0.5/10**
- The candidate's position in the order of authorship on the publications. **1/10**
- Presentations with the candidate as first author at conferences attended by the candidate. The academic committee will evaluate whether the presentation was oral or in poster form and whether the conference was national or international. **1.5/10**
- Contracts, grants and subsidies obtained by the candidate during the period of doctoral training. **1/10**
- Research visits at research centres other than one where the doctoral training was undertaken. **1/10**
- If two candidates are tied, the academic committee will establish other criteria.
- **Required complementary documentation**
- DAD of the candidate.
- List of publications deriving from the thesis: articles, patents, book chapters, conference presentations, etc., specifying as far as possible the following quality indicators of the publications: impact factor, quartile and decile of the journal, citations, reports, etc.
