

## Health, Psychology and Psychiatry - Special prizes

· Criteria and weighting

Candidates will be chosen in strict of the scores they obtain in accordance with the following criteria.

- 1. European or International Doctorate (40%)
- 2. Number of indexed publications (35%)
  - o First quartile first author
  - Second quartile first author
  - First quartile second author
  - Second quartile second author

The number of authors will be weighted as follows:

- Between 1 and 5 the weighting factor will be 1
- Between 5 and 10 the weighting factor will be 0.8
- More than 10 the weighting factor will be 0.5
- 3. International conferences (10%)
  - Oral presentations 1
  - o Posters 0.8
- 4. Short study visits abroad other than the minimum 3 month period required to obtain the European or international doctorate (10%)
- 5. Prizes and others Merits (5%)
- Required complementary documentation

Candidates must present their curriculum vitaes in which they specify the impact factor of their publications, the quartile of the journal and accrediting copies of the items that they wish to be evaluated.
